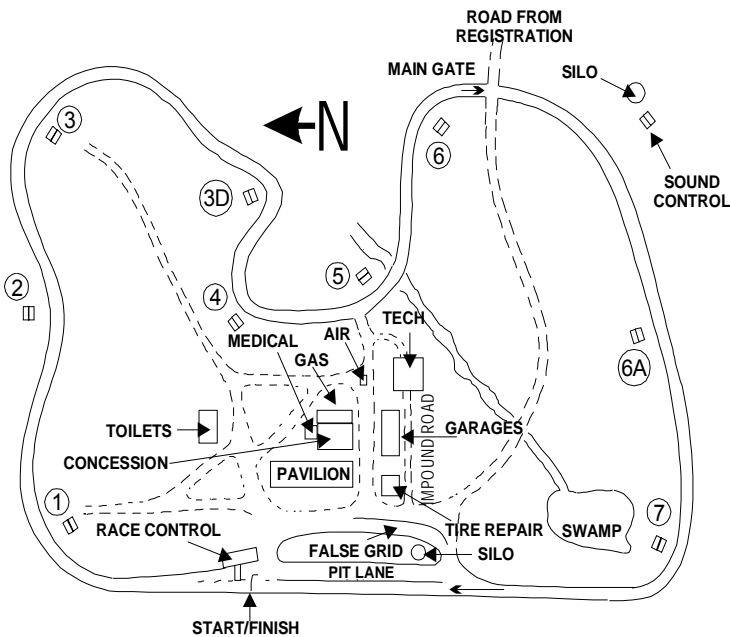

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

GENERAL

1. This event will be held in strict compliance with the 2005 SCCA General Competition Rules except as modified by these Supplementary Regulations.
2. Driver's School is open to all SCCA Novice Permit Holders holding a valid Novice Log Book. **DRIVERS WITH VALID REGIONAL OR NATIONAL COMPETITION LICENSES MAY ENTER THE DRIVER'S SCHOOL with Chief Steward approval prior to submitting entry form.**
3. **REQUESTS FOR WAIVERS of second school must be submitted in writing with the appropriate documentation (i.e. driving resume, copies of certificates, licenses, etc.) to assigned Instructors prior to the first on-track session on the morning of the school.**
4. The Regional Race is open to all drivers with valid Regional or National Competition licenses and Novice Permit drivers who have successfully completed their driver's school requirements prior to or during the Driver's School portion of this event. An SCCA Vintage license is acceptable as a Regional license. This event is also open to SCCA members who hold a full competition license with Midwestern Council, Canadian ASN license holders and/or Waterford Hill/Oakland County Sports Car Club (senior license), CASC, BMW Club Racing, PCA Club Racing, SCCA Pro Racing, FIA and IMSA. However you must still be a member of SCCA. If you are going to race with your M.C. or Waterford Hills senior license, list "Midwestern Council" or "Waterford Hills" as your club affiliation. **Novice Drivers who complete their school requirements on Friday or Saturday must return to Registration to register for the Sunday event in order to be allowed on track.**
5. Competitors whose licenses are in process may obtain confirmation that their license is valid only by the following method: the driver should arrange with the Registrar to telephone the National Office before 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, April 19, 2005.
6. Driver must supply at Registration the names of all crew and guests to be admitted under their authority. REMEMBER THAT A COMPLETED, CURRENT MINOR WAIVER FORM SIGNED BY THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH MINOR MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION FOR THE EVENT. For blank forms or more information, contact the Registrar.
7. Credentials for track entry may be obtained ONLY during scheduled registration hours - don't disappoint your guests, provide their names at registration and note the hours open!
8. Over-crew and guests will be charged \$10 for the weekend.
9. All number requests for this event will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. If you don't get your first choice you will receive a phone call.
10. Functioning AMB Tranx-260 Transponders, mounted on the racecar, will be required for **ALL** cars. **Transponder times are official.**
11. Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed in the areas of Registration, Technical Inspection, or the Impound during the times these areas are open as shown on this schedule. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE MAY BE CONSUMED BEFORE THE FINISH OF THE LAST SESSION OF THE DAY ON FRIDAY, SATURDAY OR SUNDAY.**
12. Noise Pollution Regulation Law: No Race car or other type racing engine shall be run before 8:00 AM (before 9:00AM on weekdays) or after 6:00 PM on weekends (after 5:00 PM on weekdays) unless the vehicle is muffled and street licensable.
13. Sound level readings will be taken on drivers left between corners 6 and 6A, near the silo. Sound level limits are **102dB**.
14. Checkered flags may be displayed at Corner 6A for practice sessions only. Black flags and mechanical black flags may be displayed at Corner 6A.
15. Practice times, grid positions and sound readings will be posted at the pavilion. Times are only posted for the Regional race. Grid sheets, race results and trophies will also be available at the pavilion. Trophies will be awarded, as a minimum, based on the GCR and only after results become official. Trophies are not awarded for Drivers School. **NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED.**
16. **All sessions will be limited to 47 cars on course at any time during a session or race in accordance with the GCR.**
17. Split starts are at the discretion of the Chief Steward. Split starts will be posted with the grid position posting.
18. ITE is no longer recognized by the CenDiv Champ Series. This class is for cars which have been prepared for any post or current showroom stock based road racing series sanctioned by SCCA or previously sanctioned or currently sanctioned by other pro series but which are not currently eligible

for any regional club racing class other than ITE. Cars must meet minimum safety requirements defined in the GCR and ITCS for Improved Touring cars. Cars must run DOT approved tires per GCR and fuel as defined in the ITCS. Contact the Chief of Tech to confirm eligibility. Competitor shall have a copy of the appropriate pro rules to present at tech.

19. Legend Cars (LC) are manufactured by 600 Racing and must comply with current Legend Car Rules, as published by 600 Racing. Homologation is required on all Legend Cars, and therefore they shall also comply with the SCCA Legend Car Homologation Request sheet. Competitor must be in possession of the current Legend Car Rules at all competitions. Modifications outside of those permitted in the current Legend Car rules shall render the car ineligible for SCCA Club Racing competition.
20. The racetrack may offer a test day prior to this SCCA event. The test day is NOT sanctioned by the SCCA or BVR, Chicago, LOL or Milwaukee Regions. It is NOT covered by the insurance for this event. The insurance for this event is in effect at the time Registration opens on the first day of the event. Contact the track, 815-389-2000, for information regarding the test day.

RULES OF THE ROAD

21. When entering the track from the pits the drivers must keep their car to the right of the **blend line** until they reach Corner 1.
22. Drivers must keep at least one car length spacing when entering the track through the pit lane.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

23. **All Driver's School cars** will receive a complete technical inspection at Tech Building before going on the track. Annual tech is waived for the Driver's School. *Please plan your time accordingly!*
24. Official scales will be available for competitors to check vehicle weight. See event schedule for times.
25. All drivers must stay with their car through impound if required for weigh-out. At the discretion of Tech the driver may be weighed separately.
26. **Novice Permit holders requesting a waiver of the second school must identify their cars with the novice sticker provided.**
27. Any vehicle involved in an accident during the event must be presented to the Chief of Tech at the Tech facility before being allowed on the track again.

PITS, GRIDS & PADDOCK

28. As per GCR, the hot pits shall be defined as the area from the chain-link fence to the track side concrete wall.
29. The entire track property is considered paddock. Rules will be enforced accordingly for all participants, which includes crew and guests. Access to certain portions of the track property will be limited.
30. No paddocking or parking allowed on access road(s). It may be necessary to limit support vehicles in the paddock. Car trailers are to be moved if so directed by the Paddock Marshal. Any vehicle or trailer parked in violation of the Paddock Marshal's instructions may be towed away.
31. A SLOW, SAFE AND PRUDENT speed limit in the paddock will be enforced.
32. The use of two, three or four wheeled motor driven ATV type vehicles and golf carts in the pit and paddock area is limited to STREET LICENSED DRIVERS used in the performance of duties as associated with the race. All such vehicles MUST have the class designation and car number visibly displayed of the race vehicle they are supporting, or the name of the official or specialty visibly displayed. Riding BICYCLES in the paddock area is PROHIBITED with the exception of race crews and race officials. The use of motorized and non-motorized skateboards or scooters, inline skates and roller skates are prohibited.
33. Smoking is prohibited in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
34. Proper credentials, closed shoes and shirts are required in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
35. No person shall ride on the bodywork of racecars, tow cars or on trailers.
36. Drivers will be informed at grid if there are any unstaffed corners.
37. The grid must be cleared of all crew members one (1) minute before the start of the race.
38. All trash must be placed in provided receptacles. All tires MUST be removed from the track property.
39. Food is available at the Concession Stand. Race fuel, oil, water and air are available at the track when the Corner 10 is open.
40. A hook-up fee must be paid at Corner 10 for all electrical use.
41. Reserved radio frequencies are as follows: 150.890, 151.625, 151.655, 151.895, 154.515, 154.570, 154.600, 463.225, 463.425, 464.375, 464.325, 464.525, 466.025, 467.2375, 468.0375, 469.525 MHz.

AREA 5 CHAMPIONSHIP

42. This event is an Area 5 Championship event and adheres to all rules and regulations for the area 5 championship series. Competitors must have official Area 5 decals prominently displayed to be eligible for series points. Series decals are available at Tech.

2005 SCCA Club Minor Waiver Changes

SCCA has made some changes in the Minor Waiver starting in 2004

No more “Permanent” minor waivers effective 5/1/04. The “pink” minor photo ID cards were **NO LONGER VALID AFTER THAT DATE.**

A. ANNUAL MINOR WAIVER REQUIREMENTS

An “ANNUAL” minor waiver form will need to be completed each calendar year for each minor.

A new optional “yellow” minor photo ID card is available and may be issued by the region. Must be signed by BOTH parents or legal guardians.

If there is only one parent/guardian (or a parent has sole custody), the appropriate box so attesting must be initialed by the parent/guardian on the MS_2A form. (Available at Registration).

This ANNUAL waiver is optional and not required.

B. PER EVENT MINOR WAIVERS.

Must be signed by at least ONE parent/legal guardian. Friends, relatives, brothers/sisters etc. may NOT sign the waiver on behalf of the minor.

If you are bringing minor children with you PLEASE plan on spending a little more time at Registration.
