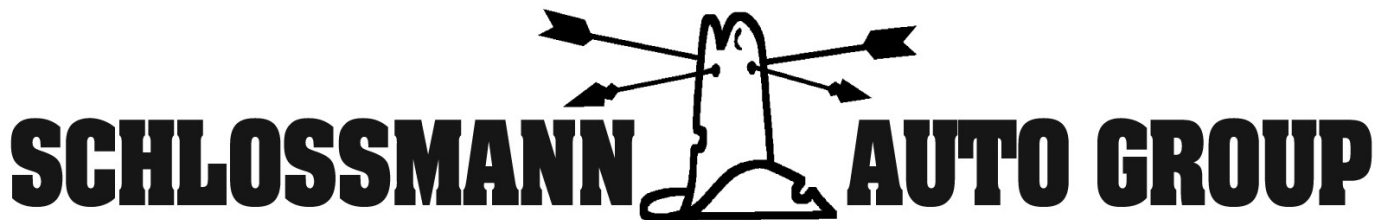
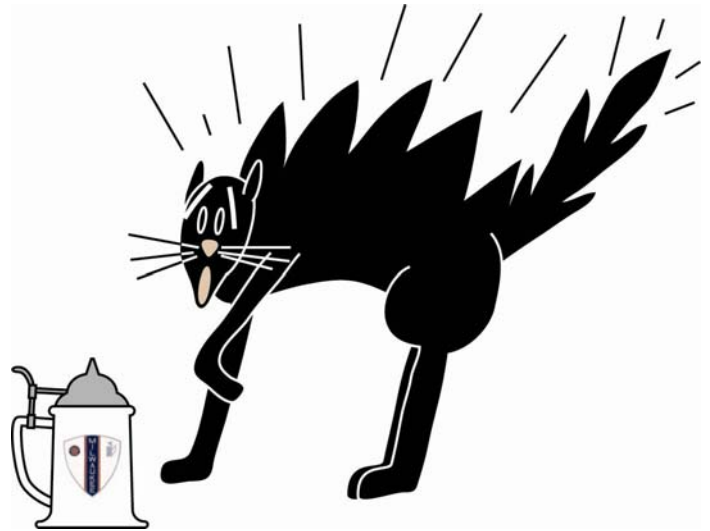

- K. Other information:
1. Mandatory Tech (GCR Re-inspection): Cars in the following classes must be presented for full technical inspection before going on the track: SM. Please plan your time accordingly.
  2. Functioning AMB TranX 260 transponders properly mounted to the competition vehicle are required for all sessions for all race classes. Transponder times are official times for all race groups.
  3. Radio frequencies 150.890, 151.625, 151.895, 154.570, 154.600, 451.825, 452.750, 457.075, 464.325, 464.375, 464.525, 469.325, 469.375, and 469.525 are reserved for race operations and may not be used by any competitors.
  4. Proper credentials, closed shoes and shirts are required in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
  5. Smoking is prohibited in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
  6. All cars needing to go to impound should exit pit lane at the center-pit opening (first opening past start/finish), go across to the second paddock road, and turn left to head to impound. If you should miss the opening, continue to the pit-out exit into the paddock, return north on the paddock road along the cyclone fence, and then join the cut across road.
  7. Attached are the Road America Rules. These rules are considered as part of these Supplementary Regulations and are enforceable as such.

## RULES OF ROAD AMERICA

- 1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - 1.1 A current -VALID spectator ticket.
    - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
    - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID "Pass-Out" upon re-entering.
  - 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY) :
    - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
    - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL, PROPERLY VALIDATED.
    - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRIST BAND.
- 2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:
  - 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
  - 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
  - 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property.
    - 2.3.1 "Pit vehicle" registration and fees must be taken care of at registration (alternate locations may apply)
    - 2.3.2 A liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance coverage for all "pit vehicles" must be signed when registering the "pit vehicles".
    - 2.3.3 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law , all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State
  - 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, SKATE BOARDS, NON-MOTORIZED SCOOTERS AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
  - 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be used in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA - this is strictly PROHIBITED.
- 3.0 ALL OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES (including golf carts) ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST POSSESS A VALID STATE-ISSUED DRIVER'S LICENSE:
  - 3.1 At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.
- 4.0 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE COMPETITION PADDOCK UNTIL AFTER ALL RACE EVENTS HAVE CONCLUDED FOR THE DAY:
  - 4.1 Spectators may only consume alcoholic beverages in the North Paddock, and other spectator areas.
- 5.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:
  - 5.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
  - 5.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
  - 5.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
  - 5.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 - 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 - 5:00 Weekdays
  - 5.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers.
- 6.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:
  - 6.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
  - 6.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.
- 7.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:
  - 7.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
  - 7.2 Kept under control of a leash.
- 8.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:
  - 8.1 Be used for cooking only.
  - 8.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
  - 8.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
  - 8.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
  - 8.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
  - 8.6 Not be near other competitors' gasoline storage areas.
- 9.0 AT NO TIME SHALL A VEHICLE BE PERMITTED TO TRAVEL COUNTER - CLOCKWISE ON TRACK!
- 10.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:
  - 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces
  - 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
  - 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on Road America property. There are fines for any destruction of property.
  - 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other's actions.
  - 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using
- 11.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!

1. This is not a spectator event. As such, credentials for track entry may be obtained ONLY during scheduled registration hours. Please provide your guests' names at registration and advise them of the hours registration will be open.
2. Over-crew and guests will be charged \$10 for the weekend.
3. All number requests for the Restricted Regional will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. If you don't get your first choice you will receive a phone call or an email.
4. Registration will be handling the sale of motor home stickers (\$50) and camping permits (\$35). These must be purchased by noon on Saturday. A Road America employee will be around to check that proper permits have been purchased. Failure to do so may result in a \$10 surcharge or eviction from the property.
5. The 4-Mile Merchant will be open in Competition Paddock for the sale of electrical hookup tags (\$20 per plug). The fee for electrical hookup is separate from and maybe in addition to any fee collected for camping or motor home privileges. Again, a Road America employee will be around to check that proper permits have been purchased. Failure to do so may result in a \$10 surcharge or eviction from the property.
6. Tent camping is free to the workers. This is being funded through the Milwaukee Region Worker Appreciation fund. You will need to obtain a camping pass when registering.
7. Noise Pollution Regulation Law: No Race car or other type racing engine shall be run before 8:00 AM or after 6:00 PM on weekends (after 5:00 PM on weekdays) unless the vehicle is muffled and street licensable. *This is reflected in the Road America Rules section of the Supplementary Regulations.*
8. Sound level readings will be taken on drivers left between corners 3 and 4.
9. Black flags and mechanical black flags may be displayed at Corner 14.
10. Qualifying times, grid positions and sound readings will be posted at the Gas Station. Grid sheets, race results and trophies will also be available at the Gas Station. Trophies will be awarded after results become official. **NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED.**
11. Road America is a 4.0 mile track.
12. Drivers may be held responsible for damages to property, including track and environmental damage.
13. Regular technical inspection will be conducted at the Road America Center (near the Mitchell Bend by Corner 13).
14. Official scales will be available for competitors to check vehicle weight. Scales are located at Impound, on the south end of the Main Paddock. See Supplementary Regulations event schedule for times.
15. Please be nice to fellow competitors and secure any cords going over an access road. This will prevent hot tires from lifting them and possibly causing needless body damage to the racecars.
16. A SLOW, SAFE AND PRUDENT speed limit in the paddock will be enforced. Speed limit is 15 mph.
17. New pit vehicle policy for Road America. Pit vehicles found in non-compliance will have their support vehicle impounded for the weekend at a minimum. The Road America rules (RA pit vehicle policy), and the application form (Pit vehicle application form), are found on the Milwaukee Region website (<http://www.scca-milwaukee.org>). Schedule”. Under “Cat National” section, select the appropriate link. The completed application form and related fee will need to be submitted at Registration.

18. Road America charges a handling fee of \$5 for every package shipped to Road America and it is to be paid prior to the delivery of the package. Fees for handling the packages will be the responsibility of the participants. There will be a minimum charge of \$50 for all shipments that need to be unloaded by Road America personnel or equipment. Packages must be labeled in the following manner: Road America / c/o (participant's name and club) / N7390 Hwy 67 / Elkhart Lake WI 53030. Contact Road America, 800-365-7223, with any questions.
19. The only areas available for paddock parking use in this event are the areas designated by Road America. Paddock parking is not allowed on the pavement under concessions stand overhangs, pavement in motor home parks, pavement by the Road America Center, or any area designated as a fire lane. When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 PM applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers. These rules will be enforced accordingly by Road America and a charge of \$500 will be levied for each infraction. This applies to drivers, entrants, crew, guests, and workers.
20. Racing fuel is available at the gas station. Contact Road America, 800-365-7223, for grades of gas available.
21. All trash must be placed in provided receptacles. Waste oil shall be disposed of in the blue barrels provided by Road America. All tires **MUST** be removed from the track property.
22. GearBox concession stand in the north paddock area will be open both Saturday and Sunday at 6:30 am. Breakfast is served 6:30 am - 11:00 am and lunch is available 9:00 am - 3:00 pm (earliest closing time, depending upon amount of business).
23. Touring will occur during lunch session at \$10 per car (free to workers). Drivers and passengers in touring cars must be over 16 years of age. Participating cars must be run through tech and display an appropriate sticker. More information will be available at Registration.
24. The Road America premises **MUST BE VACATED** by 7:00 pm on **SUNDAY**, July 29. Road America may levy a charge against offenders.

# **MINOR WAIVER REMINDER**

Every minor (under the age of 18) needs a signed minor waiver in order to be able to enter the track premises. **A new waiver must be filled out each CALENDAR year.**

The minor waiver form is a 2-part form. Only a parent or legal guardian can sign the form.

**ANNUAL WAIVER:** For an Annual Waiver, the form **MUST** be signed by **BOTH** parents or legal guardian(s). **The signatures must be witnessed by an SCCA licensed Registrar or the waiver form has to be notarized.** If there is only one parent/guardian or if a parent has sole custody, the appropriate box so attesting must be initialed by the parent/guardian. A minor photo ID (valid only for the calendar year) can be issued after the new Annual Waiver is completed. There is a charge for this photo ID.

**SINGLE EVENT MINOR WAIVERS:** For a single event, the minor waiver must be signed by at least ONE parent/legal guardian. **The signature on this must be witnessed by an SCCA licensed Registrar or Steward whether at or away from the event site or it may be notarized.**

Please, please, please remember, and remind your guests and crew that if they are not the parent or **legal** guardian of the minor they are bringing to the track, the minor must have a waiver signed by his/her parent or legal guardian and witnessed by a licensed Registrar or a Steward or the form must be notarized. **WITHOUT A SIGNED WAIVER THE MINOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE TRACK!!!!!!!**

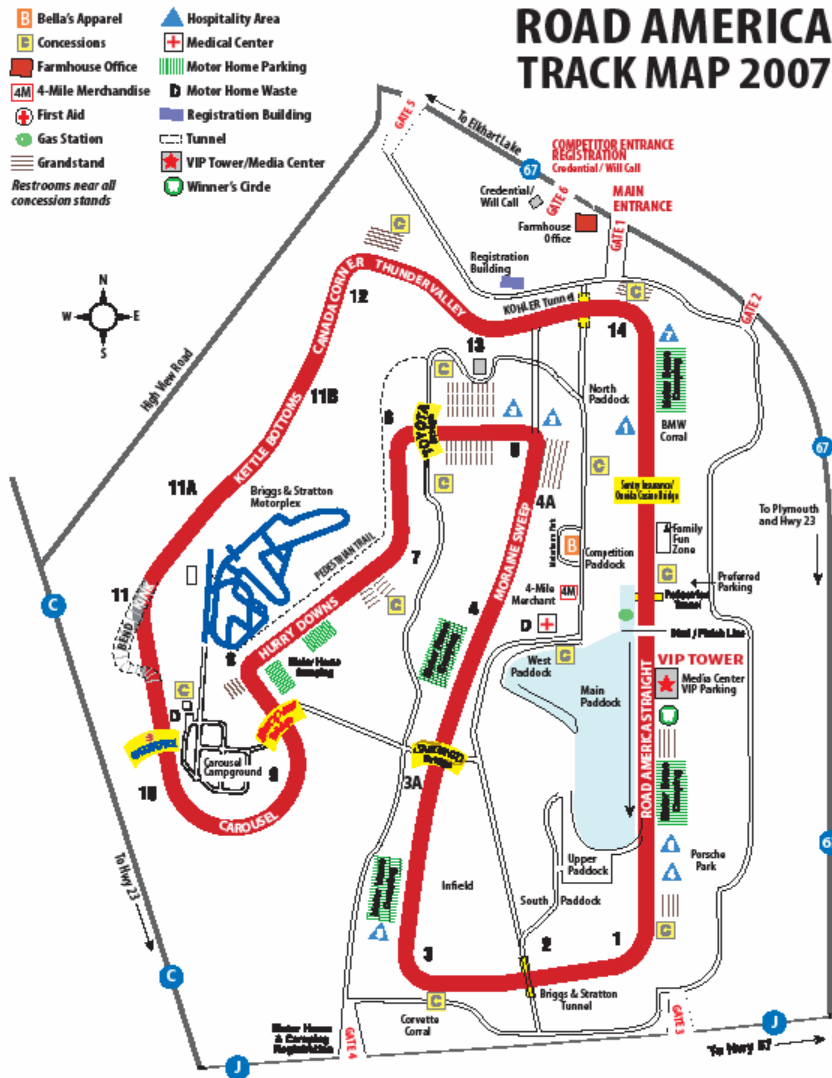
### **Travel through Milwaukee**
