- A. Susie Bonneau Memorial Double Regional Races, Road America, Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin, May 31 – June 1, 2008.
- B. Sanction # 08-RS-78-S and 08-RS-79-S Double Regional Races.
- C. This event is organized by the Milwaukee Region of Sports Car Club of America, Inc. (SCCA) and will be held under the current SCCA General Competition Rules and current Fastrack updates, except as amended by these Supplemental Regulations. This regional race is open to all SCCA Novice Permit holders who have satisfied the school requirements, to current holders of SCCA Regional, Vintage or National licenses, and to SCCA members who hold other SCCA approved licenses, per the GCR.

- E. This is a Double Regional Race event. 35 minute qualifying session with 10 lap races. Race Groups are reflected on the Supplementary Regulations Event Schedule page.

- I. Race results and trophy distribution will be per the GCR and Fastracks.
- J. Official scales availability is reflected on a separate page of the Supplementary Regulations.
- K. Other information:
1. Mandatory Tech (GCR Re-inspection): Cars in the following classes must be presented for full technical inspection before going on the track: ITA, ITB, ITC, ITE2, ITE1, ITS, and ITR. Please plan your time accordingly.
  2. Functioning AMB TranX 260 transponders properly mounted to the competition vehicle are required for all sessions for all race classes. Transponder times are official times for all race groups.
  3. Radio frequencies 150.890, 151.625, 151.895, 154.570, 154.600, 451.825, 452.750, 457.075, 464.325, 464.375, 464.525, 469.325, 469.375, and 469.525 are reserved for race operations and may not be used by any competitors. The Region reserves the right to designate other frequencies for race administration.
  4. Proper credentials, closed shoes and shirts are required in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
  5. Smoking is prohibited in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
  6. Noise Pollution Regulation: No racing engines, including showroom cars with open exhaust, may be run before 8:00 AM or after 6:00 PM. On Friday, no race engines may be run after 5:00 PM. Maximum sound reading allowed by local ordinance is 103dB. During the race you will be black flagged after 3 sound violations and moved to last finishing position with a loss of event points (if you had a race finish).
  7. All cars needing to go to impound should exit pit lane at the center-pit opening (first opening past start/finish), go across to the second paddock road, and turn left to head to impound. If you should miss the opening, continue to the pit-out exit into the paddock, return north on the paddock road along the cyclone fence, and then join the cut across road.
  8. FM tire rules (GCR Sections 9.1.1.F.14.A, B, C and D) are not in effect. Instead the following rules apply to FM.
    - i) A competitor shall start the race on tires used in a qualifying session for the race as identified by markings made on the tires by a race official. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that his or her tires are appropriately marked prior to (e.g. on the false grid), during, or immediately after (e.g. as the car leaves the track) a qualifying session.
    - ii) For races with more than one qualifying session, a competitor shall start the race on any marked tires from any qualifying session for the race.
    - iii) If a competitor chooses to start the race on any tires that were not used in a qualifying session for the race and not appropriately marked, the competitor shall forfeit his or her grid position and start from the back of the grid. This forfeiture of grid position shall not apply if all qualifying sessions for the race were run under rain or wet conditions.
    - iv) A complete set of four (4) rain or wet track tires may be used at the competitor's discretion for any race. Rain tires may be in new or used condition and require no special marking if used as a complete set of four.
  9. Attached are the Road America Rules. These rules are considered as part of these Supplementary Regulations and are enforceable as such.

## **RULES OF ROAD AMERICA**

### **1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- 1.1 A current –VALID spectator ticket.
  - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
  - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID “Pass-Out” upon re-entering.
- 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY) :
  - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
  - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL, PROPERLY VALIDATED.
  - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRIST BAND.

### **2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:**

- 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
- 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
- 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property.
  - 2.3.1 “Pit vehicle” registration and fees must be taken care of at registration (alternate locations may apply)
  - 2.3.2 A liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance coverage for all “pit vehicles” must be signed when registering the “pit vehicles”.
  - 2.3.3 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law , all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State
- 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATE BOARDS, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SCOOTERS (THOSE KIND YOU STAND ON) AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
- 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be used in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA – this is strictly PROHIBITED.

### **3.0 ALL OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES (including golf carts) ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST POSSESS A VALID STATE-ISSUED DRIVER’S LICENSE:**

- 3.1 At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

### **4.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:**

- 4.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
- 4.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
- 4.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
- 4.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 – 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 – 5:00 Weekdays
- 4.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers.

### **5.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:**

- 5.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
- 5.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.

### **6.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:**

- 6.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
- 6.2 Kept under control of a leash.

### **7.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:**

- 7.1 Be used for cooking only.
- 7.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
- 7.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
- 7.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
- 7.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
- 7.6 Not be near other competitors’ gasoline storage areas.

### **8.0 AT NO TIME SHALL A VEHICLE BE PERMITTED TO TRAVEL COUNTER – CLOCKWISE ON TRACK!**

### **9.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:**

- 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces
- 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
- 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on Road America property. There are fines for any destruction of property.
- 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other’s actions.
- 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using

### **10.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!**

### **11.0 VENDING** is not allowed on Road America property without obtaining the proper permit. To obtain such permit, a vendor fee must be paid. This fee varies per event. Contact Road America for details and prices and to make arrangements.
