General Regulations:

1. The Race Chairman will lay out the track to his specifications in a round-ish, oval-like, square-ish pattern.
2. All boxes must be paper based-type boxes. Wood, metal, plastic are not allowed.
3. All entries NP and BP class must have 3 participants, one of whom must be in the box as a rider.
4. All entries in NP2 and BP2 must have at least 3 but not more than 5 participants, 2 of whom must be in the boxes as riders.
5. At least one member of the team has to pull the box.
6. Rope or similar material must be used to pull the box.
7. All entries must be "powered" by human(s). No motorization allowed.
8. All boxes must be completely sealed on the bottom.
9. The bottom of the box(es) must be flush with the ground.
10. No wheels, treads, glides/runners are allowed on the box.
11. Transponders are not required.
12. 4 classes - NP, NP2, BP and BP2
 - **NP Class**
 - Boxes, tape, rope, cutting devices will be provided.
 - A green flag will be dropped at the start at which time each CBR team will build their box and go to the Start/Finish line to being their race laps.

- **NP2 Class**
 - Same as NP class except in keeping with the Siamese theme, there must be 2 boxes with a riders for each.
 - Said boxes must be attached to and flush with each other and can be side-by-side or in tandem.
 - **BP Class and BP2 Class**
 - Boxes may be prepared - get it? **Be Prepared** - in advance following the above regulations for the specific class (**NP/BP, NP2/BP2**).
 - Decorating the outside of the Cat Box is encouraged.
 - Boxes and teams will be lined up at the Start/finish line to start their race.
13. Number of groups for each class to be determined by the number of entries for that class.
 14. Number of race laps TBD -- usually at least one or until all the boxes fall apart.
 15. Radio frequencies 150.890, 151.625, 151.895, 154.600, 451.825, 452.750, 457.075, 464.325, 464.375, 464. 525, 469.375 and 469.525 are reserved for race operations and may not be used by competitors.
 16. Trophy distribution will be determined at the event.
 17. Smoking is prohibited in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
 18. In case of inclement weather, a Box d'Elegance display of boxes will be held in lieu of races. NP and NP2 classes will be given 5 minutes to complete their entries.
 19. The Chief Steward reserves the right to amend, modify, or supplement these regulations at her whim.
