

- A. Susie Bonneau Memorial Double Regional Races, Road America, Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin, July 24 & 25, 2010.
- B. Sanction No. 10-RS-1182-S and 10-RS-1183-S Double Regional Races.
- C. This event is organized by the Milwaukee Region of Sports Car Club of America, Inc. (SCCA) and will be held under the current SCCA General Competition Rules and current Fastrack updates, except as amended by these Supplemental Regulations. This regional race is open to all SCCA Novice Permit holders who have satisfied the school requirements, to current holders of SCCA Regional, Vintage or National licenses, and to SCCA members who hold other SCCA approved licenses, per the GCR.

K. Other information:

- 1. Functioning AMB TranX 260 transponders properly mounted to the competition vehicle are required for all sessions for all race classes. Transponder times are official times for all race groups.
- 2. Radio frequencies 452.700, 457.700, 461.150, 461.325, 462.200, 463.700, 464.075, 461.175, 463.225, 464.525, 466.175, 468.225, and 469.525 are reserved for race operations and may not be used by any competitors. The Region reserves the right to designate other frequencies for race administration.
- 3. Black flags and mechanical black flags may be displayed at Corner 14. The black flag steward will be located near the end of the pit lane.
- 4. Proper credentials, closed shoes and shirts are required in the pits, grid and false grid areas.

5. Smoking is prohibited in the pits, grid and false grid areas.
6. Noise Pollution Regulation: No racing engines, including showroom cars with open exhaust, may be run before 8:30 AM or after 5:00 PM on weekdays and before 8:00 AM or after 6:00 PM on weekends. On Friday, no race engines may be run after 5:00 PM. Maximum sound reading allowed by local ordinance is 103dB. During the race you will be black flagged after 3 sound violations and moved to last finishing position with a loss of event points (if you had a race finish).
7. FE and FM tire markings will be available on the false grid before qualifying session.
8. All cars will exit the pits only at Pit Out. Those cars needing to go to Impound will proceed to the second paddock road, turn right and head north to impound.
9. Paddock restrictions: There may be restrictions on areas available for paddock. Area designated as restricted cannot be used during the weekend. These areas will be posted at Registration.
10. This is a CenDiv Championship Series points event. Preregistration is required for participation in the series. Series rules, including regional-only car classes, can be found on the CenDiv website at <http://www.cendiv-scca.org/>.
11. The Road America premises **MUST BE VACATED** by 7:00 pm on SUNDAY, July 25, 2010. Milwaukee Region will pass the Road America late fee on to any offenders.
12. Attached are the Road America Rules. These rules are considered as part of these Supplementary Regulations and are enforceable as such.

RULES OF ROAD AMERICA

1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.1 A current –VALID spectator ticket.
 - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
 - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID “Pass-Out” upon re-entering.
- 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY) :
 - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
 - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL, PROPERLY VALIDATED.
 - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRIST BAND.

2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:

- 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
- 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
- 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property.
 - 2.3.1 “Pit vehicle” registration and fees must be taken care of at registration (alternate locations may apply)
 - 2.3.2 A liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance coverage for all “pit vehicles” must be signed when registering the “pit vehicles”.
 - 2.3.3 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law , all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State
- 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATE BOARDS, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SCOOTERS (THOSE KIND YOU STAND ON) AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
- 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be used in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA – this is strictly PROHIBITED.

3.0 ALL OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES (including golf carts) ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST POSSESS A VALID STATE-ISSUED DRIVER’S LICENSE:

- 3.1 At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

4.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:

- 4.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
- 4.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
- 4.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
- 4.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 – 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 – 5:00 Weekdays
- 4.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers.

5.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:

- 5.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
- 5.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.

6.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:

- 6.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
- 6.2 Kept under control of a leash.

7.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:

- 7.1 Be used for cooking only.
- 7.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
- 7.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
- 7.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
- 7.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
- 7.6 Not be near other competitors’ gasoline storage areas.

8.0 AT NO TIME SHALL A VEHICLE BE PERMITTED TO TRAVEL COUNTER – CLOCKWISE ON TRACK!

9.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:

- 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces
- 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
- 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on Road America property. There are fines for any destruction of property.
- 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other’s actions.
- 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using

10.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!

11.0 VENDING is not allowed on Road America property without obtaining the proper permit. To obtain such permit, a vendor fee must be paid. This fee varies per event. Contact Road America for details and prices and to make arrangements.

MINOR WAIVER REMINDER

Every minor (under the age of 18) needs a signed SCCA minor waiver in order to be able to enter the track premises. **A new waiver must be filled out each CALENDAR year.**

The SCCA minor waiver form is a 2-part form. Only a parent or legal guardian can sign the form.

SCCA ANNUAL WAIVER: For an SCCA Annual Waiver, the form **MUST** be signed by BOTH parents or legal guardian(s). **The signatures must be witnessed by an SCCA licensed Registrar or the waiver form has to be notarized.** If there is only one parent/guardian or if a parent has sole custody, the appropriate box so attesting must be initialed by the parent/guardian. An SCCA minor photo ID (valid only for the calendar year) can be issued after the new SCCA Annual Waiver is completed. There is a charge for this photo ID.

SINGLE EVENT MINOR WAIVERS: For a single event, the SCCA minor waiver must be signed by at least ONE parent/legal guardian. **The signature on this must be witnessed by an SCCA licensed Registrar or Steward whether at or away from the event site or it may be notarized.**

Please remember, and remind your guests and crew that if they are not the parent or **legal** guardian of the minor they are bringing to the track, the minor must have an SCCA minor waiver signed by his/her parent or legal guardian and witnessed by a licensed Registrar or a Steward or the form must be notarized.

WITHOUT A SIGNED WAIVER or CURRENT SCCA MINOR PHOTO ID, THE MINOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE TRACK!!!!!!!

I. Registration Procedure

- A. Entries are not official until the entry form is received, paid, and accepted. We are not responsible for entries lost/delayed in transit, failed online submission, or failed emails. Telephone entries will not be accepted. Email entries without a valid credit card number will not be processed. Bad/returned/NSF checks and/or refused credit card charges will cause the entry to be considered a late entry. The late entry fee is \$40.00. Personal checks, cash, cashiers checks, traveler's checks, and Visa/MasterCard will be accepted. (See I.B. for online payment info).
- B. Make all checks payable to Milwaukee Region SCCA. Please note checks are not accepted for entries submitted through www.MotorsportReg.com. Entries will NOT be processed without a payment.
- C. Milwaukee Region reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. An entry will not be accepted unless the full entry fee accompanies the entry form. Requests for refunds after the notification date will incur the cancellation fee and must be made in writing to the Milwaukee Region SCCA no later than 7 days after the event.
- D. Milwaukee Region Refund Request Policy: Entrants who are entered in both events and incur damage during the first day and cannot run the second event will receive a prorated refund but they MUST NOTIFY THE REGISTRAR before the end of the event weekend.
- E. Credentials for one driver and up to three (3) crew members will be issued at registration. Three additional crew passes and extra guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 each. Up to six (6) crew members are allowed in the pits at one time. There is no charge for guest passes for minors 12 and under. Credentials for track entry may be obtained ONLY during scheduled registration hours. Please provide your guests' names at registration and advise them of the hours registration will be open.
- F. License confirmation: Competitors whose licenses are in process at the time they wish to race must obtain confirmation that their license is valid by arranging with the Registrar to telephone the National Office in Topeka.
- G. No one will be permitted in the Competition Paddock area until properly registered through SCCA Registration.
- H. At the time of registration, you must present the following:
 - 1. Current SCCA license or valid (signed-off) SCCA Novice Permit.
 - 2. Current membership card or proof of membership.
 - 3. SCCA Photo ID. Photo IDs will be available for a nominal fee.

II. General

- A. Black Flag station will be located at the south end of pit lane near Pit Out.
- B. The traffic flow in the main paddock will run south along the pit lane and north on the parallel paddock road by the garages.
- C. Qualifying times, grid positions, results and sound readings will be posted at the Gas Station. Grid sheets, race results and trophies will also be available at the Gas Station. Trophies will be awarded after results become official. **NO TROPHIES WILL BE MAILED.**
- D. Drivers may be held responsible for damages to property, including track and environmental damage.
- E. Road America is a 4.0 mile track.
- F. Touring will occur during lunch session at \$10 per car (free to workers). Drivers and passengers in touring cars must be over 16 years of age. Participating cars must be run through tech and display an appropriate sticker. More information will be available at Gas Station.
- G. Lost and found for cars parts and pieces lost on track is at the Black Flag Station or with the Course Marshalls at corner 5. Personal items like glasses, cell phones will be at the SOM room behind Paddock Medical.

III. Special Track Amenities and Regulations

- A. See Rules of Road America in the Supplementary Regulations for more track rules.
- B. Road America has always done their best to provide us with access to the facility for parking on the day before the event prior to 7 PM. Only if the group running on the track that day releases early will parking be allowed to begin prior to the stated 7 PM.
- C. Registration will be handling the sale of motor home stickers (\$50) and camping permits (\$35). These must be purchased by noon on Saturday. A Road America employee will be around to check that proper permits have been purchased. Failure to do so may result in a surcharge or eviction from the property.
- D. The 4-Mile Merchant will be open in Competition Paddock for the sale of electrical hookup tags (\$20 per plug) for pit lane, upper paddock, and in the trees motor home. There are NO water hook-ups available. The fee for electrical hookup is separate from and maybe in addition to any fee collected for camping or motor home privileges. Again, a Road America

employee will be around to check that proper permits have been purchased. Failure to do so may result in a surcharge or eviction from the property.

- E. Please observe a quiet time between 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. daily. Each campsite or motor home must have an adult. Sites must be kept clean and free from all debris. Glass bottles or containers are not permitted.
- F. Tent camping is free to the workers. This is being funded through the Milwaukee Region Worker Appreciation fund. Workers will need to obtain a camping pass when registering.
- G. Pit vehicle policy for Road America. Pit vehicles found in non-compliance will have their support vehicle impounded for the weekend at a minimum. The Road America application form and related rules are found on the Milwaukee Region website (<http://www.scca-milwaukee.org>). Under "Road Racing, click on "2010 Schedule & Results". Under "Susie Bonneau Memorial" section, select the "RA pit vehicle registration form" link. The completed application form and related fee will need to be submitted at the Administrative Office.
- H. Road America charges a handling fee of \$5 for every package shipped to Road America and it is to be paid prior to the release of the package. Fees for handling the packages will be the responsibility of the participants. There will be a minimum charge of \$50 for all shipments that need to be unloaded by Road America personnel or equipment. Packages must be labeled in the following manner: Road America / c/o (participant's name and club) / N7390 Hwy 67 / Plymouth WI 53073. Contact Road America, 800-365-7223, with any questions.
- I. Racing fuel is available at the gas station. Contact Road America, 800-365-7223, for grades of gas available.
- J. Breakfast and lunch will be available at the GearBox concession stand in the north paddock.
- K. The Road America premises MUST BE VACATED by 7:00 pm on SUNDAY, July 25, 2010. Milwaukee Region will pass the Road America late fee on to any offenders. Road America does not allow motor homes, trailers, rigs, etc. to be left on the property after the conclusion of an event. If a participant wishes to do this, Road America will charge a storage fee. Security or the Administrative Office should be contacted to make such arrangements. Those items left here without going through the proper procedures will be impounded and returned to the owner only after the impound fees and other associated costs are paid to Road America by said owner.

IV. Technical and Safety Inspection

- A. Regular technical inspection will be conducted at the Road America Center (near the Mitchell Bend by Corner 13 or in the impound area. Refer to the schedule to obtain the location.
- B. Official scales will be available for competitors to check vehicle weight. Scales are located at Impound, on the south end of the Main Paddock. See Supplementary Regulations event schedule for times.
- C. The scales and tech impound location will be further south from Pit Out on the same paddock road in the main paddock.

V. Rules of the Paddock

- A. Please be nice to fellow competitors and secure any cords going over an access road. This will prevent hot tires from lifting them and possibly causing needless body damage to the racecars.
- B. A SLOW, SAFE AND PRUDENT speed limit in the paddock will be enforced. Speed limit is 15 mph.
- C. The only areas available for paddock parking use in this event are the areas designated by Road America. Paddock parking does not include pavement in the motor home parks, pavement by the Road America Center, covered scale area or any area that is designated as a fire lane. Parking is not to occur in any area designated as a fire lane or other non-traditional parking spaces such as on the grass behind the VIP Tower or pavement not marked for parking spaces and parking is only allowed in the reserved media parking spaces along the south tree line of the VIP tower parking. When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 PM applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers. These rules will be enforced accordingly by Road America and a charge of \$500 will be levied for each infraction. This applies to drivers, entrants, crew, guests, and workers.
- D. All vehicles and trailer must be parked in accordance with Paddock Marshal's instructions.
- E. Vehicles and trailers parked in Fire Lanes, unauthorized areas, or parked in violation of the Paddock Marshal's instructions will be towed away without notice.
- F. No one shall ride on the bodywork of race cars, tow cars, or trailers.
- G. All trash must be placed in provided receptacles. Waste oil shall be disposed of in the blue barrels provided by Road America. All tires MUST be removed from the track property.
